Financial Assistance & Taxes

- The Maryland Department of Commerce is offering three new business assistance programs in response to the COVID-19 pandemic:
 - 1. Maryland Small Business COVID-19 Emergency Relief Loan Fund This \$75 million loan fund offers no interest or principal payments due for the first 12 months, then converts to a 36-

- month term loan of principal and interest payments, with an interest rate at 2% per annum. Learn more.
- 2. Maryland Small Business COVID-19 Emergency Relief Grant Fund This \$50 million grant program offers grant amounts up to \$10,000, not to exceed 3 months of demonstrated cash operating expenses for the first quarter of 2020. Learn more.
- 3. Maryland COVID-19 Emergency Relief Manufacturing Fund This \$5 million incentive program helps Maryland manufacturers to produce personal protective equipment (PPE) that is urgently needed by hospitals and health-care workers across the country.
