



MEMBERSHIP INVESTMENT GUIDELINE

Membership rates are based on the total number of full-time equivalent employees (unless business type listed in the “Other Rates” section). Employee count is calculated by totaling the total hours worked per week of all employees/40. Owners are considered “employees.” There is a one-time processing fee of \$40 for new members that is paid at the time of initial membership.

Membership investment in the Hudson Area Chamber of Commerce & Tourism Bureau may be tax deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense, but not as a charitable tax deduction for federal tax purposes. The Chamber is not a charity, but serves as an advocate organization for area businesses.

Retired Individual: \$160 *Available to an independent citizen, retired, not associated with a business.*
