Just The Facts...

Established in 1849, Putnam County is bordered by Flagler, Volusia, Marion, Alachua, Bradford, Clay, and St. Johns counties and is named for Benjamin Alexander Putnam (1801-1869) who was a lawyer, soldier, judge, member of the state legislature, and the first president of the Florida Historical Society.

Putnam County is located approximately 50 miles south of Jacksonville (via U.S. Hwy 17), 90 miles north of Orlando (via U.S. Hwy 17), 30 miles west of Saint Augustine (via State Rd 207), and 45 miles east of Gainesville (via State Rd 20).
