YEAR-ROUND OPPORTUNITIES

Weekly Business Luncheons: The Fairbanks Chamber's Business Luncheons are known to be the best in the state. With educational and informative guest speakers and an average of 100 business leaders in attendance each week – our weekly lunches are a great opportunity to showcase your business.
