SUBMIT AN ABSENTEE BALLOT!

Why?

AVOID LINES & CROWDS! | VOTE FROM THE SAFETY OF YOUR OWN HOME

How?

STEP 1: FILL OUT AN ABSENTEE BALLOT APPLICATION FORM.

- You probably got one of these in the mail from SD Secretary of State Steve Barnett within the last month. Follow the instructions that came with the application.
- If you already threw it away and are now regretting it, you can get that same application online at <https://sdsos.gov/elections-voting/assets/AbsenteeBallotApplicationFillable.pdf>.

STEP 2: MAKE A COPY OF YOUR PHOTO ID.

- Acceptable forms of photo ID include: SD driver's license or non-driver ID card, passport or other picture ID issued by the U.S. government, tribal photo ID, current student photo ID issued by a SD high school or postsecondary education institution
- Don't have access to a copy machine? Just roll through the drive-up window of one of the banks listed here and ask them to make a paper copy for you. (Aren't our local banks awesome??)
- Don't want to bother with a paper copy? Just take a picture of your ID and email it to the Yankton County Auditor's Office with the subject line "For Absentee Ballot Application". NOTE: *You still need to physically sign your absentee ballot application and snail mail that to the auditor's office. Do not email the application.*

STEP 3: MAIL YOUR FORM AND WAIT FOR YOUR ABSENTEE BALLOT TO ARRIVE.

STEP 4: CAST YOUR VOTE(S) AND MAIL YOUR BALLOT IN!
