



## Host a Mock Interview Session for a Muskego High School Student Between April 1st and April 18th

The Muskego Chamber of Commerce is organizing Mock Interviews in partnership with the Muskego High “School to Work” program. The goal is to help students prepare for their desired career. The Chamber is organizing businesses who are available to do an interview *at their location*. This new format more realistically portrays the job search process and allows students to receive valuable feedback from experienced, business people. There are approximately 50 students signed up to do a Mock Interview. If your business has several career opportunities that fall within one of the career cluster categories, please consider hosting several students.

Students are asked to:

- Sign up for an industry-specific interview. (The teacher will assign them the specific business from the list the Chamber provides.)
- Contact the assigned business for an interview. These must occur between April 1st and 18th.
- Arrive in a timely fashion and present themselves appropriately for the interview.

Interviewers are asked to:

- Treat the interview as if hiring for the position.
- Fill out an evaluation form provided by the high school (the Chamber office will help distribute these).
- Provide the student with positive, realistic feedback after the interview.
- Email the evaluation form to the student’s teacher.

The High School [Career Clusters](#) guide helps students plan career paths. We recommend that you view the guide to understand the various careers listed under each category.

Please note that the goal is to reveal career diversity within each industry and help students understand that careers have more than one path. Example: The medical field offers more careers than just nursing and doctoring. Students may discover they prefer working in administration, project management, or as a technician within a specific field while being an employee of a healthcare system.
