



Muskego Area Chamber of Commerce Student Volunteer Scholarship Application Form

Technical College, Trade School, or Apprenticeship Program (Value: \$1,000)

The Education & Mentoring Committee of the Muskego Area Chamber of Commerce represents business members dedicated to education and workforce training. This annual scholarship is available to any high school senior who currently resides in the Muskego, Big Bend, Wind Lake, or Town of Norway communities.

Review the requirements carefully as incomplete applications, handwritten essays, or late submissions will not be considered. Applications and essays containing grammatical or spelling errors receive lower scores.

Applications are due by **February 8, 2019** and must include:

- A brief cover letter (up to one page) introducing yourself to the committee
- A printed, completely filled out application form that details the following information:
 - ◊ Volunteer and community service experience (considered highest priority for scholarship)
 - ◊ Volunteer participation during high school (work prior to high school is not considered)
- Attach a recent high school transcript showing:
 - ◊ Academic achievements (secondary priority for this scholarship)
 - ◊ Grade Point Average (used to support your post high school education choice)
- Two letters of recommendation from non-family members
 - ◊ One letter from a non-profit organization where you participated as a volunteer
 - ◊ One letter from a teacher, employer, or business acquaintance
- A typed, two-page essay that includes the following information:
 - ◊ Your intended technical college, trade school, or apprenticeship program
 - ◊ How your past service experience influences your current career choice
 - ◊ The field of study you selected, the reason you chose this career, and any preparations/ activities you did to prepare for this program
 - ◊ Your career goals

Volunteer work may include: participation in community events and service clubs; faith-based activities; programs for elderly, children, or special needs individuals; and, charitable events. Student service activities will be considered if volunteer activities are included (Student Government, Honor Society, Tutoring).

Sports involvement is not considered volunteer work.
