President's Message



Hurricane season started this past Friday. We are in for a busy season if Subtropical Storm Alberto is any indication. Colorado State University's Tropical Meteorology Project forecasts above-average activity in the Atlantic in 2018 with 14 named storms, 7 becoming hurricanes and 3 reaching major hurricane strength.

I traveled to Washington, DC from May 14 - 17 to participate in various activities celebrating Asian American/Pacific Islander Heritage month:

• Attended a dinner hosted by the National Asian/Pacific Islander American Chamber of

- Commerce and Entrepreneurship (ACE) for MOU partners (other Asian Chambers of Commerce),
- Attended the National Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Business Summit hosted by the Minority Business Development Agency
- Attended the Asian Americans in Energy, Environment and Commerce (AE2C) discussion with FERC Commissioner Neal Chatterjee
- Visited Capitol Hill to meet Representatives and Senators to advocate <u>for</u> continued funding of the Minority Business Development Agency and <u>against</u> the inclusion of a question on citizenship in the 2020 U.S. Census
- Attended the Asian Pacific American Institute for Congressional Studies (APAICS)
 Awards Gala.

This was an excellent trip. I learned a great deal from meeting leaders of other Asian Chambers and participating in Capitol Hill meetings.

Barbara Gallo and I attended a presentation by representatives of the U.S. Census. In addition to the national census of all individuals living in the U.S. the Census Bureau also surveys businesses every 5 years (we're currently in the 2018 national survey of business owners). This survey, required by law, provides the most up-to-date information about all business operating in the U.S. Results of this survey are used by businesses to plan their activities and investments. It is available free of charge and can be accessed through the U.S. Census Bureau website

(https://factfinder.census.gov/faces/nav/jsf/pages/index.xhtml).

Later in June, ACC Board member Walter Lawson and I will travel to Austin to meet with Asian Chamber leaders from Austin, San Antonio and Dallas. We will discuss how to coordinate our efforts to advance Asian community and Asian business interests at the state and national levels.

The ACC Scholarship Awards banquet will be held Thursday, June 7 at the Brae Burn Country Club on 8101 Bissonnet Street. Please join us as we recognize 10 outstanding students for their academic and civic accomplishments with scholarship awards to assist in financing their college education.

We have been alerted by the FBI to a Houston telephone scam where someone, reportedly from the Chinese consulate, speaking Mandarin says the call recipient needs to send money for any one of a variety of reasons. The Chinese consulate issued a warning on their website (http://houston.china-consulate.org/eng/sgxw/t1552242.htm). The scam hit New York City in April and NYC victims have lost almost \$3 million dollars to the scammers.

Finally an early reminder that our 2018 Spirit of Entrepreneurship Gala will be held Friday, October 26 at the Royal Sonesta.


