From **ST. PAUL PIONEER PRESS**: Minnesota Gov. Tim Walz has put the final touches on his four-part, \$2 billion package for public construction projects. That price tag is a record amount for public works projects. On Wednesday, Walz announced his requests for police

and fire stations, National Guard armories, local roads and bridges and other public safety projects, plus state grants to cities and counties to build town halls, libraries, parks, trails and other local facilities.
