WHERE CAN I BUY MY TICKET?

Tickets are available by visiting www.darienchamber.com, click on "Events" in the header and select "Brew & Chew Fundraiser" in the dropdown menu. This will direct you to the registration page to purchase your tickets.

WILL TICKETS BE AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT THE DOOR?

WHAT DO I GET FOR THE PRICE OF MY TICKET?

Ticket prices include a commemorative tasting glass, 18 beer tickets (one 3 oz. beer sample per ticket), and tasty food from Chuck's Southern Comforts Café.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN VIP TICKETS AND GENERAL ADMISSION TICKETS?

VIP ticketholders enjoy express entry and can enter the festival **1 hour early** to take advantage of private samplings from 6pm to 7pm. VIP ticketholders will also receive a free swag bag. Please note: VIP is limited to the first 50 registered. General Admission ticketholders can enter the festival at 7pm.

HOW DOES THE DESIGNATED DRIVER TICKET WORK?

Designated Drivers must be 21+ years old with a valid photo ID to attend the festival. We are proud to support the Designated Drivers who attend the festival to ensure a safe ride home for their friends and family.

All DD's must purchase a \$20 Designated Driver ticket and they will not receive beer tickets or a tasting glass. Designated Drivers will wear a different colored wristband and will not be permitted to sample any beer. Any person witnessed to be in violation while wearing this wristband will be immediately escorted off the event premise.

Unlimited soda and water will be available and the price of their ticket will include food from Chuck's Cafe.

WHY ARE THERE BEER TICKETS?

This is a regulatory measure to keep in compliance with current Illinois liquor laws. Brew & Chew ticketholders will receive 18 drink tickets. Each ticketholder must exchange one drink ticket per 3 oz. sample. Additional drink tickets are available for \$1.00 per ticket.

WILL FOOD BE PROVIDED?

Yes, Chuck's Cafe will be making food for the event!

CAN I BRING MY FAMILY?

This is strictly a 21 and over event. All attendees must present a valid government issued I.D.

CAN I BRING MY OWN BEER?

No outside food or drinks are allowed inside the festival – this includes bottled water. Once inside the fest, there will be complimentary water for drinking and rinsing your glass.

WILL THERE BE A COAT CHECK?

No, however a coat closet will be available in the lobby at Chuck's Café

I CAN NO LONGER ATTEND, CAN I RECEIVE A REFUND?

No, all ticket sales are final – no refunds or exchanges

INTOXICATED GUESTS

All guests of Brew & Chew Ale Fest are expected to drink responsibly and ensure they have a safe, responsible means of transportation before leaving the facility. Any guest who is intoxicated before entering the event may be denied entry to the facility. Any guest found intoxicated within the event and causing a disturbance, as determined by management, will be asked to leave the facility without refund and may be subject to further consequences.

RULES AND RESTRICTIONS

- ◆ Must have Driver's License or Other Government Issued form of I.D. that verifies legal drinking age of 21.
- ◆ All tickets are final sale and no refunds shall be given for any reason
- ◆ Each beer sample is limited to a three (3) ounce pour. Tasting glasses, drink tickets, and programs will be given out upon admittance to the event.
- ◆ Consuming alcohol can be dangerous to your health and will impair your ability to perform certain activities, including, but not limited to, your ability to operate a motor vehicle. You knowingly and voluntarily assume all risk of injury or loss that may result from your consumption of alcohol at the festival.

- ◆ We reserve the right to remove any individuals that any staff member believes that is too intoxicated or behaving in an uncivil manner.
- ◆ Promotional photos and video will be taken at the event and you grant permission for your likeness to be used.
- ◆ You are not permitted to consume any alcohol of any kind obtained at the Festival outside of Chuck's Southern Comforts Café. You are not allowed to bring any food, drink or outside glassware into the Chateau Orleans Banquet Rooms.
