



## **Ambassador 'Chamber Bucks' Reward Programs**

### **Member Referrals**

As a valued member of the Ambassador Committee, you can play an active role in helping your Chamber grow its membership base. When you refer businesses to us that become members of the organization you are contributing to the vitality of the Chamber and the area business community, a broader base with which our members can network and create productive business relationships, and to the continued success of your colleague's business.

One of the best compliments we can receive is for our members to refer businesses to become members. We want to recognize and thank you for your commitment and support of the Chamber through these referrals. For *each* referral that results in membership you will receive \$25 'Chamber Bucks'. 'Chamber Bucks' can be used to offset any participation/entry fees for Chamber events within one year of receipt. The more business referrals you provide that become members of the Chamber, the more opportunities you have to earn 'Chamber Bucks'.

Please note, referrals must result in a new Chamber membership.

### **Ambassador Representation at Events**

As an Ambassador you are asked to attend ribbon cuttings and Chamber events to serve as Chamber greeters and volunteers often serving as part of the first impression members and guests receive of the Chamber.

We want to recognize your time and dedication and reward you for your service at these events. For every three events that you attend each quarter in an Ambassador role, the Chamber will enter your name in a general membership drawing to receive \$50 in 'Chamber Bucks'. 'Chamber Bucks' can be used to offset any participation/entry fees for Chamber events within one year of receipt. It will be the Ambassadors' responsibility to check in at the event registration table or report event attendance at the next scheduled Ambassador meeting.

#### **Ambassador Roles**

**Greeter** = greeting members and guests once they arrive to the event/meeting. This is typically a minimum of 40 -minutes at each event/meeting which includes following up with any new member or guest immediately at the end of the event/meeting.

**Volunteer** = On some occasions Ambassadors are asked to *staff the registration table* which can involve at least a 45-minute commitment including welcoming members and guests and checking individual's names against a registration. Ambassadors may also be asked to serve in other roles at events/meetings which would additionally include serving as an extension of the Chamber as a representative at ribbon cuttings.
