



THE PROGRAM

Leadership Preble County is helping develop a pool of community leaders with the skills and vision to creatively address community issues. The program prepares its graduates to serve on boards and task forces. It is creating a network of individuals who will in turn use their awareness of the community's strengths, weaknesses and opportunities to improve the quality of life in Preble County.

Leadership Preble County begins in October with orientation, includes an overnight retreat in November led by Lisa Nack of Pathway Guidance, and continues through June with 12 half-day sessions, ending with graduation in June. The sessions are conducted by leaders in their fields who will cover topics related to the specific day. Each session will be led by a facilitator/day chair or Leadership Preble County graduate. Session schedule subject to change, pending session presenters' needs.

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Attendance at the retreat is mandatory. The retreat begins at noon on Friday, November 16 and runs through noon, Saturday, November 17. The retreat will be held at PVM Camp & Conference Center.

2. Participants are expected to attend all half-day programs in addition to the opening retreat. Program days may begin around 7:30 AM and last until 1 pm. Some sessions may run longer and last until 3 p.m. Eighty percent attendance is required for graduation.
3. Attendance for less than half of the scheduled program day may be counted as an absence.
