Wednesday, Sept. 2, 11 a.m.-noon


Preparing employees for a potential active shooter incident is an integral component of an organization's incident response planning. Because active shooter incidents are unpredictable and evolve quickly, preparing for and knowing what to do in an active shooter situation can be the difference between life and death. Every second counts. Unique Training Opportunity: The Preble County Chamber of Commerce and the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), a component within the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, are hosting a one-hour virtual training session on Wednesday, Sept. 2, from 11 a.m. to noon, that is designed to enhance awareness and preparedness for active shooter incidents. Need an intern?

The Diversity & Inclusion Technology Internship Program, an internship program administered by the Ohio

Development Services Agency, is designed to support startups and small businesses with high quality, low cost internship opportunities. The program is now accepting applications. ODSA will reimburse two-thirds of the wages paid (up to \$10,000) to an intern acquired through the program. Companies can either be a tech-focused company or any company with the need for a tech-focused intern. During this time of social distancing, the internship allows for and encourages, remote or telework opportunities. Companies can hire as many as three (3) interns for different positions. The minimum wage for interns is \$15 per hour but can exceed that amount. The internship period begins on Nov. 1 and ends on April 30, 2021.
