Preble Arts is offering social distancing camps, workshops. "The safety of your children and your family is our biggest priority," PCAA Executive Director Vicky Fanberg provided an update yesterday. "As we prepare for camp, we are following all state guidelines for proper social distancing procedures. Camp size will be limited to 8 campers per session and each child will have their own table and pre-sanitized supplies, to ensure social distancing throughout the day. We are also following state guidelines of handwashing and other sanitizing practices to create a healthy environment. We CANNOT offer the extended lunch periods between camps. We need this time to properly clean and sanitize before the next group of campers arrives. We CANNOT provide snacks and ask that you pack a light snack and water bottle for your child. Our staff will wear a mask at all times and we invite you and your child to do the same. Drop-off and pick-up procedures are changed during this time as well and will be communicated to you prior to your camp start date.
