The Leadership Center is home to both Leadership Greater New Haven (LGNH) and Executive Orientation (XO). These two programs offer aspiring community leaders a series of practical hands-on intensive training in professional development and education in social and economic issues.

LGNH is a 7-session program for professionals of all levels working in the for-profit, nonprofit, and government sectors. Covered topics include: Understanding New Haven's Assets and Opportunities, Goal Setting, Public Speaking, Personal Branding, Empathy in the Workplace, and Arts in the region. This program specifically equips business executives with the skills, techniques, and business connections in New Haven to compete and be successful in the region.

Different from LGNH, the XO is an abbreviated 4-session program with topics that are designed for senior executives in for-profit, nonprofit, and government sectors, interested in exploring and understanding the relevant issues, resources, economics and dynamics of the Greater New Haven region. This program aims to facilitate strategic connections between participants in the XO program and influential decision makers and leaders within the Greater New Haven area.
