Assemblyman Stephen Choi has named Kim Le as 2020 Women of the Year for the 68th Assembly District.

Senate passes \$480 billion package to expand funding for small-business loans and testing.

The Senate has passed an estimated \$484 billion infusion of funds for small businesses, hospitals, and COVID-19 testing as the economy continues to reel from the pandemic. The chamber on April 21 passed the Paycheck Protection Program Increase Act on a voice vote, sending the bill to the House for approval. House Majority Leader Steny Hoyer indicated that a vote could take place as early as the morning of April 23.
