Sessions will be held during regularly scheduled school days. All students will be responsible for coordinating assignments and exams with their teachers prior to the session dates. **There is a possibility that if you are a year-round student; session dates may fall on intersession. The attendance to LFYA is still mandatory.** To graduate from Leadership Fayetteville Youth Academy, **each participant is expected to attend all sessions.** Please take note that leaving early is very difficult on many of our days. Leaving early will count as a missed session. Please schedule other extracurricular activities, meetings, appointments etc. around the one day a month program schedule.

Becoming a part of the Leadership Fayetteville Youth Academy, you will be required to have an email account for the Program Manager to be able to keep in contact with each student.

Student behavior during and outside of program time can be held against students. If behavior in or outside of school reflects poorly on the student, support for their participation may be removed at any time and students may be expelled from the program.
