Selection Criteria

Participants are chosen based upon the information completed for this application. Representation will be sought from a cross-section of the community and will:

- Select a diverse group of individuals who represent different occupations, backgrounds, interests, and talents;
- Select individuals with a sincere commitment, motivation, and interest in serving their community;
- Select individuals who have demonstrated involvement by past community activities;
- Select individuals who will commit, participate, and attend all sessions in this year's project;
- Select individuals interested in serving the program post-graduation.

A maximum of 30 participants will be selected for each year. Selected participants will be notified of their acceptance. A complete packet ensures that each applicant understands and can comply with the application requirements.

Tuition

For a year-long membership with Leadership Fayetteville, the program is scheduled from September to May of each year. The tuition is \$950.00 and includes meals, transportation and administrative costs. Tuition is non-refundable.

Attendance

The Leadership Fayetteville program includes nine day-long sessions, once a month from September through May, which will occur on the last Thursday of each month, with the exception of December which will be held on. Session days begin at 8:00am and will conclude at 5:00pm. You will also be asked to participate in a class service project to be decided upon as a class and completed before graduation.

Attendance is monitored and absenteeism may result in dismissal from the program. **Only two (2) absences from the program will be allowed.
