Jeff's Place Children's Bereavement Center, Inc. offers FREE peer based support groups for children and teens, age's preschool through high school, and their caregivers coping with a meaningful death loss.

Our mission is: "No child should grieve alone." We always need volunteers to assist with administrative/organizational tasks, Special Events, grant writing, or to be trained as a volunteer facilitator.

Our volunteer facilitators help co-lead the bereavement support groups. All volunteer facilitators must complete a 24 hour comprehensive training offered at our office in Framingham at various times throughout the year. Our volunteers must be good listeners, open, and committed to helping the families we serve. We do ask that they make a year-long commitment, although our program does not run in the summer. Our groups either meet on Monday's in Wayland or Thursday's in Framingham. Our groups meet typically bi-monthly and facilitators are on site from 5:30pm to 9:30pm. This time includes a pre-session, dinner with the families, a candle lighting ceremony, groups, and a post-session.

Our support groups are 100% FREE to our families and our program would not be able to run without our caring, committed, and compassionate volunteers!
