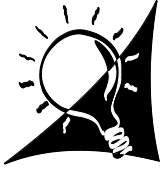

*What are our long-term objectives for this Committee? (2-3 years)*

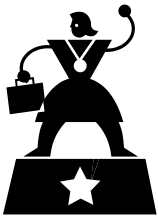
- Act as a catalyst for existing MCOE, College of Marin & Dominican University career-related and pathways programs by facilitating healthy student internship experiences in Marin County.
