San Rafael Chamber Supports Marin General Retrofit and Rebuild

SAN RAFAEL, CA – Chamber leadership announced today their support of the upcoming bond measure that will rebuild the aging Marin General Hospital. The measure will be on the ballot in Marin County this November and will generate approximately 394 million dollars to help rebuild and seismically retrofit the hospital. Marin General is one of the largest employers in Marin County and has an annual economic impact on the county of over 1 billion dollars. Last year, Marin General Hospital provided more than \$43 million in community benefit, most of which was in form of medical care for low income residents.

"The Chamber is committed to the economic vitality and health of our community. Our Board is supporting the bond measure for Marin General Hospital because the hospital generates enormous positive economic and community impact. Marin General Hospital is a tremendous community asset that should be preserved and enhanced for our future generations."

The bond measure will require a super-majority (66%) in order to pass this November.
