Formed by the public to provide more renewable power and reinvest funds into our local economies, MCE launched in San Rafael in 2010. MCE customers eliminated more than 300,000 metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions from 2010-2017 — the equivalent of removing over 64,000 cars from the road for one year.

MCE continues to exceed state renewable energy supply standards and greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets. We achieved California's renewable energy goals 11 years ahead of state targets, and we will meet GHG-free goals 23 years early. MCE's standard **Light Green** service is guaranteed 50% renewable, while our elective **Deep Green** option is 100% California renewable energy. Both options represent a significant reduction in greenhouse gas emissions and dependence on fossil fuels — all at comparable rates. Half of the revenue generated by the Deep Green premium is used to fund the development of new, local renewable energy projects like MCE Solar One in Richmond, the Bay Area's largest publicly owned solar farm.

MCE provides service to approximately 470,000 customers in Marin County, Napa County, unincorporated Contra Costa County, and the cities of Benicia, Concord, Danville, El Cerrito, Lafayette, Martinez, Moraga, Oakley, Pinole, Pittsburg, Richmond, San Pablo, San Ramon, and Walnut Creek. By choosing MCE, customers help support new in-state and local renewable energy projects and jobs.

Marin is home to several renewable energy projects developed in partnership with MCE, including rooftop solar panels at EO Products and the San Rafael Airport, built under the MCE feed-in-tariff (FIT) program. MCE offers one of California's most generous FIT programs, where local businesses can install a solar project on rooftops, parking lots, or other unused space to tap into a brand-new revenue stream while contributing to a fossil-free energy future.

Additionally, to help business customers save on their utility bills, MCE offers rebates and low-cost financing options that can be repaid through your monthly PG&E bill, helping to incorporate energy-efficient, sustainable practices that will have your business running smooth and green.
