



Marin General Hospital 2.0: Making Great Progress

In 2020, we will open our new earthquake-safe hospital (MGH 2.0) on the campus of Marin General Hospital. The modern, high-tech hospital will provide a patient-focused atmosphere that reflects the natural healing environment of Marin that surrounds us every day.

We have made great progress already. We completed a new staff parking garage, installed a crosswalk and light at Schultz Memorial Drive, expanded the entrance and exit, and changed signage to redirect patients and visitors. Now, the crew is building the foundation and connecting existing buildings to the new facility.

The need for a hospital replacement building is clear. Our existing buildings are aging; one of which is not compliant with new seismic safety standards. If we hadn't addressed the seismic safety issue by 2030, we would be forced to close by law.

In addition, MGH 2.0 is needed to accommodate our growing population and to accommodate the advanced medical services our community needs. Almost three years ago, we took our vision to the community, asking the voters to approve a \$394M general obligation bond. Funds from the bond would provide the hospital with the financial foundation to move forward. The voters passed Measure F with a more than two-thirds majority. The community's participation didn't stop there. A bond oversight committee, has been meeting regularly since then to monitor expenditures using Measure F bond funds and reporting its findings.

I am confident that we can work together to minimize inconveniences and address concerns of local residents, patients, and employees as we grow. Our staff and physicians have done an exceptional job in delivering high quality care during this transition. I have great pride and gratitude for their continued contribution to our success.
