7. Stays informed about committee matters, prepares themselves well for meetings, reviews, and comments on minutes and reports.
8. Builds a collegial working relationship with other committee members that contributes to consensus. Willing to be objective to all proposals brought before the Board.
9. Participates in the Chamber's annual evaluation and planning efforts, determine the goals and objectives of the Chamber annually.
