

# Caroline County Seat: Denton

Denton is the county seat for Caroline and always worth a visit, whether for business or pleasure.

The best place to start when exploring Denton is the town square on Market Street, where the Caroline County Courthouse is located, as well as a tiny but helpful visitor information booth.

The square is surrounded by many of the town's important buildings, including Town Hall, the sheriff's office, the main branch of Caroline County Public Library and the Museum of Rural Life.

Two of the county's most popular dining establishments, Market Street Public House and Harry's on the Green, can also be found on the square, as can Turnbridge Point, a beloved B&B which also has a gift shop offering merchandise and yummy baked goods.

From the square, many of Denton's other attractions can be reached by foot: the Fiber Arts Center of the Eastern Shore, The Foundry gallery and gifts, numerous Market Street shops and the Chesapeake Culinary Arts Center.

A quick, downhill stroll brings you to the Choptank River, where guests can stop



by the Wharves of Choptank Visitor and Heritage Center or take in the scenery at Crouse Mill Park. Across the river, you can pick up a visitors guide at the Caroline County Office of Tourism or, in the warmer months,

enjoy a sightseeing tour aboard River Run Cruises.

This very walkable town is just a starting point. There are many enjoyable destinations throughout the county, so ask around — your new neighbors will be happy to
