CAROLINE COUNTY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE 2018 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

For 2018, the Chamber intends award three \$1,000 scholarships to three qualified graduating seniors, with one of the scholarships being dedicated to a CCTC graduate (distribution may be based on the applicant pool).

The applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a resident of Caroline County, Maryland
- Be a graduating senior
- Have acceptance into a trade, two year, or four year school
- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 non-weighted on a 4.0 scale
- Involvement in clubs and community activities preferred but not required
- Work experience for a local business during his/her high school years – preferred but not required

Attachments required:

- A copy of the acceptance letter from a trade, two year, or four year school ***
- A copy of transcript
- Three letters of recommendation; school, community leader, and/or business owner
- Short essay about your future plans and how this scholarship would impact you. (1 page, double spaced, between 250 - 300 words)

Applicants should mail or drop off their completed application package to the Caroline County Chamber office **no later than 4:30 pm on Friday, April 27, 2018**. Late applications will not be considered. Following review by the Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Committee, scholarship recipients will be notified prior to graduation.
