Leadership Chillicothe was developed in 1989 to assist in developing the future leaders of the area. Up to 15 participants will be selected for the 2019 program based on strict criteria including: motivation and interest to serve in the Chillicothe area, potential or existing opportunities for advancement to leadership positions, willingness to commit time and energy to complete the program, and full support of the corporation/organization that is represented. Leadership Chillicothe is an intensive seven-month program beginning in April with an overnight retreat and ending with a graduation in October.

Program

Leadership Chillicothe will focus on developing valuable leadership traits including but not limited to self-awareness, core values and collaboration while also covering local topics ranging from healthcare to infrastructure and beyond. Additionally, the class will develop a project to be carried out that will have a positive influence and fill a need within the Chillicothe community.

Requirements

- Attendance at each session – *there will only be one allowable absence*
- Completion of community project to be developed by class
- Support of affiliate business or organization

Goals

Enhance the leadership skills of participants to improve Chillicothe's future; familiarize participants with the community's opportunities, needs, issues & resources; establish effective peer relationships between participants and community leaders; educate participants on how to move people & ideas to action.

Registration

Tuition to participate in the program is \$450 for Chamber members and \$650 for non-members.

Registration fee covers materials and all program related expenses including the overnight retreat. Tuition is payable by the individual, employer or sponsoring organization and is non-refundable after March 29, 2019.
