Eligibility Guidelines

1. The selected students must be a graduating Senior, completing high school in the current academic year at Waunakee Community High School.
2. The selected students must have a parent or guardian that is a member in good standing with the Waunakee Area Chamber of Commerce, or the student must be employed at a Chamber Member Business.
3. The selected students must be registered as a full-time student (12 credits minimum) at an accredited college or technical school in the fall of 2019.
4. The selected students must volunteer for eight (8) hours at a Chamber related activity before school starts in the fall of 2019. Opportunities include the WaunaFest Run, office assistance and Chamber-Business community partnerships programs.
5. The selected students will be presented the scholarship at the WHS Senior Academic Awards Night in May of 2019.

2. Include **TWO** letters of recommendation: *One from a **teacher or administrator** and *One from a **work or volunteer/community service supervisor**.
