Lunch & Learn discusses Caregiver Burnout

At this month's Connect4Lunch Katie Drea, Resident Care Director at [Sylvan Crossings in Westshire Village](#), lead a discussion on caregiver burnout. As the American elderly population increases, more and more individuals find themselves in the position of providing care to loved ones.



Caring for a loved one can be very rewarding, but it can also be very stressful; adapting to changes in the family dynamic, dealing with household disruption and financial pressure, providing daily personal care and other additional workload can all lead to caregiver burnout. Katie recommends when a caregiver is reaching their limit to speak up, ask for help, say yes when help is offered and try to spread the responsibility of care giving to as many family and friends as possible. Split tasks among several people to make a light load for a few rather than a heavy load for one. The presentation concluded with a question/answer session. 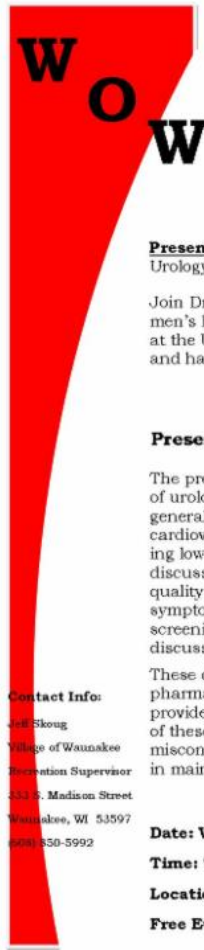

"Men's Health in 2015"

Presenters: Drs. David Paolone and Dr. Granville Lloyd, Department of Urology at UW School of Medicine and Public Health

Join Drs. David Paolone and Granville Lloyd for a conversation about men's health issues. Both are urologists in the Department of Urology at the University of Wisconsin School of Medicine and Public Health and have particular interest in Men's Health.



Presentation Overview

The presentation will cover several key points in regards to the number of urological conditions that can affect a man's overall well-being and general health. The relationship between erectile dysfunction and cardiovascular health will be emphasized. The controversies surrounding low testosterone and testosterone replacement therapy will be discussed. The impact of lower urinary tract symptoms on a man's quality of life as well as the variety of treatment options for those symptoms will be reviewed. Finally, the importance of prostate cancer screening done in an appropriate and evidence-based manner will be discussed.

These conditions are commonly discussed in the media and in pharmaceutical advertisements, and the goal of the presentation is to provide clarity regarding the appropriate evaluation and management of these conditions. The presentation will attempt to correct any misconceptions and stress the importance of men taking an active role in maintaining wellness.
