Whitefish Huckleberry Days Arts Festival August 11, 12 & 13, 2017

The Whitefish Chamber of Commerce invites you to participate in the **28th Annual Huckleberry Days Art Festival**. The festival will again be held in Depot Park located in the heart of downtown Whitefish, near the Whitefish Library and our train depot. As you know the park has large trees, a beautiful lawn and is accessible from four streets.

The fair is open to **Hand Crafted** items that are an original creation of the vendor. Each application is scrutinized carefully to make sure items are hand crafted. We require you to submit the following photos: One of your booth as set up for a show, one of you working on your product and one of a close up of your product. Artwork is juried throughout the application process, based on the date that your application is received. Photos by email or on a CD are the preferred format, as they can be used for promoting future shows. (Print photos are acceptable, however.) Email jpg format photos to: lisa@whitefishchamber.org Please include in your subject line "2017 Huckleberry Days Artist Photos – Your Name"]. Prior participation does not guarantee acceptance into this year's show. Upon acceptance to the festival you will be sent further information regarding the show & location of your booth.

Note: If you are selling food products (including bottled jams, dressings, etc.) you will need a current license valid to sell food products in the State of Montana (contact Darren Woeppel or Jesse Green at 406-751-8130 for licensing information).

Spaces will be assigned on a first come policy. We make every attempt to fulfill artists' requests. Booth fee checks or money orders should be made out to Whitefish Chamber of Commerce, P.O. Box 1120, Whitefish, MT 59937. To pay by credit card, please call our office at (406) 862-3501, Visa/Mastercard accepted.

While overnight security will be provided, the Whitefish Chamber of Commerce is not responsible for any theft, loss or damage to artwork or booths at the Huckleberry Days Arts Festival. Artists are responsible for any damage caused by themselves, their artwork, tent and display. Festival management is not responsible for any damage, loss or injury resulting from participation in the Huckleberry Days Arts Festival. **Tent stakes or driving on the grass in Depot Park is not permitted - this will be strictly enforced.** Come prepared for sun, wind, rain, cold or other acts of Mother Nature.
