# MEMBER SPOTLIGHT

## The Clinton Woman's Club (CWC)

George M. Curtis was a Clinton industrialist in a community noted as a sawmill capital in the second half of the 19th century. The George Curtis house is typical of the architectural style popular in the late Victorian period in America. The decorative interior millwork is exemplary of the Curtis Company products.

The Clinton Woman's Club (CWC) was organized in November 1912, and was affiliated with the Iowa Federation of Women's Clubs in 1913. The Woman's Clubs acquired the George M. Curtis house and carriage house in 1925. The historical and architectural importance of this residence was recognized in October 1979 when it was placed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Curtis Mansion Historical Foundation's (CMHF) goal is to enlighten and educate the community on the history of the mansion and what it was like to live in the Victorian Era by focusing on the Victorian architecture of this 20 room Queen Anne style mansion and the Victorian gardens. This can only be done through the preservation of this piece of history, which is accomplished through donations from the public, community organizations, and the tireless efforts of a team of volunteers.



These two organizations serve to preserve the mansion and grounds, the CWC, which purchased the mansion in 1925 and is primarily responsible for utilities, insurance, maintenance and grounds, marketing, tours, club programs and events, rentals and minor interior repairs, and the CMHF, a 501 (c)(3) organization, is primarily responsible for fundraising, grants, exterior repairs and major interior repairs. The New Friends of the Mansion group, under the auspices of the CMHF, will provide new opportunities for men, families and community businesses and organizations to be involved with the preservation of the mansion. The George M. Curtis Mansion is a beautiful venue to host Bridal/Baby Showers, Small Wedding Receptions, Tea Parties, Birthday Celebrations, Prom Dinners, Business Meetings, Luncheons, Holiday Parties.

## **Clinton Community College Celebrates 70th Anniversary**

Clinton Community College hosted a 70th Anniversary Celebration Open House and "Sneak Peek" at the Library Enhancement Project on December 7th at the main campus, 1000 Lincoln Boulevard, Clinton.

The history of Clinton Community College covers more than 70 years. In March 1946, a public referendum was presented to the citizens of Clinton. The answer was a resounding "yes" and on September 9 of that year, Clinton Junior College officially opened its doors.

Housed in the Clinton High School building, more than half of the first class of 86 students were World War II veterans having recently returned home from the war. The college continued to grow through the years and eventually outgrew its shared quarters at the high school. It proudly moved into a new building on September 6, 1965, with an enrollment of 555 day students. Today, more 1,700 students are enrolled each semester in a variety of Arts &

Science transfer courses and Career & Technical programs.

Clinton Community College has invested \$11 million in improvements to the teaching and learning environment since 2007 when the voters of Eastern Iowa Community College District approved a bond referendum. CCC President Karen Vickers commented, "We are very excited to share our latest renovation with our community! The work to update our library has been in the works for some time and we are eager to have it open for our students and community. This latest project is helping us to continue to improve the learning environment for our students."

New construction, remodeling and enhancements that have occurred since 2010 include:

Library Enhancements are designed to improve the environment where students do research and gather to work on projects, where area workforce trains or retrains for a new career, and where the community can read newspapers, magazines, books and do research.

Lecture Hall Renovations create the classroom environment for excellence in teaching and learning.

Microbiology & Biology Labs were redesigned to incorporate lecture and lab into one seamless educational experience.

State-of-the-art technology is utilized throughout the classrooms, labs, and lecture halls at Clinton Community College.

Student Success Center offers students free tutoring services, with emphasis in math and sciences.

Financial Services Area offers easy access to Financial Aid and Business Services.

Science Addition totals 8,000 square feet including the Chemistry and Physics labs, preparation area, plus faculty offices.

CCC Maquoketa Center was opened in Fall 2009 and serves Jackson County.
