Noblesville Announces Small Business Resilience Grant Recipients

NOBLESVILLE, IN (April 8, 2020) – Mayor Chris Jensen announced today the 46 local establishments that are recipients of the Noblesville Small Business Resilience Grant, which awarded a total of \$250,000.

The grant was created last week to help small businesses with unmet immediate needs such as maintaining payroll, paying rent and utilities, and covering other expenses to remain operational and serve customers and clients. Based on demonstrated need, the grants provided up to \$10,000 per small business impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

“Small businesses are crucial part of the fabric of our community and it is our hope that these grants will provide assistance and promote economic vitality within the city,” said Jensen. “COVID-19 has impacted nearly every segment of our national and local economy. Due to required closures and other restrictions imposed to protect public health, many local businesses have experienced severe reductions in revenues.”
