DISPLAY:

Entries will be on display in the George W. Carver Early Education Center Cafeteria. The CTR Committee reserves the right to exhibit artwork as space and criteria permit, and to disqualify and remove any entry that does not comply with the eligibility requirements listed below, even after payment is received.

DEADLINE:

Entries must be submitted to the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce no later than **4:00 pm Friday, June 7, 2019**. Entries will not be accepted after this date and time.

A junior exhibitor must be 17 years of age or younger at the time of the festival and reside in Lockhart and/or attend Lockhart ISD.

You (Exhibitor) warrant and represent, in respect of the entry submitted by you, as follows:

You are the sole owner and author of the entry and that the entry originated within the past two calendar years.

You have the right to make your entry available to the competition.

The entry does not contain personally identifiable information about you or any other person(s).

The entry does not contain any infringing, threatening, false, misleading, abusive, harassing, libelous, defamatory, vulgar, obscene, scandalous, inflammatory, pornographic or profane content.

The entry does not contain any material that could constitute or encourage conduct that would be considered a criminal offence, give rise to civil liability, or otherwise violate any law.

The entry does not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, contract rights, or any other intellectual property rights of any third person or entity, or violate any person's rights of privacy or publicity.

You confirm that each person depicted in the entry has granted permission to be portrayed as shown.

You confirm no animals were harmed or manipulated in the making of the entry.

COPYRIGHT PERMISSION:

Entry into the exhibition automatically grants copyright permission for any images to be used for publicity and/or promotional purposes, which may include print, website, or video for and about Chisholm Trail Roundup Rodeo and Music Festival.

SECURITY:

Overnight security is provided, however, the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce, CTR, Lockhart Independent School District, and the City of Lockhart will not be held responsible for lost or stolen items.

RAIN POLICY:

The CTR Festival will continue, rain or shine, with no refund of fees.

RETURN POLICY:

By entering the contest, you indicate that you understand and agree that your artwork, if judged as Best in Show, will not be returned, and becomes property of Project Graduation. Unsold artwork can be picked up from the Chamber office Monday, June 17, 2019. Artwork not picked up by Friday, June 21, 2019 will be considered abandoned and become the property of the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce. Abandoned items will be auctioned to the highest bidder at the Lockhart Chamber of Commerce Annual Banquet or other fundraiser endeavors of the CTR Committee's choosing.
