

Tyler, TX Ranked 28th Best City in the U.S. For Teachers

New report shows Tyler is a great place for educators to live and work

Charlotte, N.C. GoodCall - A new report released by the [GoodCall](#) research team shows that Tyler was just ranked the 28th best place in the U.S. for teachers. The rankings were based on data collected from the U.S. Census Bureau, the National Center for Education Statistics and Indeed.com.

Tyler made the list due to high teacher pay, along with strong educational values, a low cost of living, and a solid job market for teachers. According to GoodCall analysis, Tyler has an average teacher salary of \$47,950, paired with a low cost of living index. There were 19 available teaching jobs in the city at the time of the report's publication.

"Teaching as a profession has grown more challenging in recent years, due in large part to budget cuts and high-stakes testing," says Paul Southerland, Senior Analyst for GoodCall. "Our goal was to find places that still offer a great quality of life for teachers."

The methodology for the report took into account the average salary, number of teaching jobs, teaching jobs per capita, high school graduation rates, cost of living and amenities score for cities nationwide.
