Every even numbered year, a delegation of Tyler Area Chamber members travel to Washington, D.C., to participate in the Texas Association of Business National Affairs Conference. This two day conference is the stage where important information is exchanged between business and Congressional leadership and potential impact of their actions or inaction is discussed. Of the many law and rule changes being proposed in Washington, there are two specifically, that our Chamber Committees can help provide clarification and impact on our business community. The first, the National Labor Relation Board's efforts to overturn the long standing "Joint Employer" standard. The second, the U.S. Department of Labor's draft rules to expand overtime pay to salaried employees. A joint meeting of the Government Affairs and Education HR Committees to hear more on these two issues, is scheduled for August 1st, at noon, in the Genecov Room. You will not want to miss this joint committee meeting.

On the transportation front, NET RMA Vice Chairman Gary Halbrooks reported at the June meeting of the Tyler Area Chamber of Commerce, a successful Transportation Bond sale for Segment 4 of the NETRMA's Toll 49 project has taken place. Construction of the "Lindale Relief Route" is to begin soon and has a proposed completion date of June 2018. At completion, the number of toll transactions is expected to double on this critical transportation artery.

You all have seen articles in the newspaper and have heard news reports of the recent shortfall of sales tax revenue affecting services provided by the City of Tyler. "Buy Tyler Area First", has been a cornerstone of my year as your Chamber Chairman. Everything we purchase has an impact on the prosperity of our community. So now, my ask is simple, before you make a purchase online, please "Buy Tyler Area First."


