# Hillsdale Local School District 2007-2008 Profile

**Location:** Hillsdale Local School District is located in southern Ashland County midway between Mansfield and Wooster off of U.S. Route 30 on CR 30-A approximately 12 miles east of the U.S. Route 30 and Interstate Route 71 intersection. The district covers 96.22 square miles.

The district borders on Wayne, Holmes, Knox and Richland Counties; district territory in Ashland County includes Mohican, Montgomery, Perry, and Vermilion townships and the villages of Hayesville and Jeromesville. District residents are part of the 16<sup>th</sup> Federal Congressional District, 19<sup>th</sup> or 22<sup>nd</sup> Ohio Senate District, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, 90<sup>th</sup> or 97<sup>th</sup> Ohio House Districts. The district population is 6,200 (2000 Census). The median income is \$32,705. District expenditure per pupil in 2007 was \$7.742

**District:** Hillsdale Local School District is comprised of one elementary (K-4), one middle school (5-8), and one high school (9-12).

In 2006-2007 the district met 26 of the 30 indicators on the State Local Report Care and received an "Effective" rating; the district met Average Yearly Progress (AYP) in all categories and achieved a Performance Index (PI) of 98.0

**Faculty and Staff:** Hillsdale Local School District has 72 licensed/certified educators, two guidance counselors, three principals, one athletic director, and 45 support staff. 53% of the instructional staff hold a master's degree, and 98.7% of the instructional staff hold Highly Qualified Teacher (HQT) status.

**Enrollment 2007-2008:** District enrollment K-12 is 1121. Building level enrollment is Hillsdale Elementary School 377; Hillsdale Middle School 340; and Hillsdale High School 404.

### Students with Special Needs K-12

Students with special needs are provided a continuum of services designed for specific learning disabilities in one or more of seven categories as designated by federal law. Placement in this program is determined following a multidisciplinary evaluation. In all programs an individual education plan is developed for each student, stating annual goals and short-term objectives. All programs are designed to provide the opportunity to learn in the least restrictive environment.
