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Mapleton Local School District 2007-2008 Profile

Location: Mapleton Local School District is located in northern Ashland County on County Road 801 about 3 miles from the intersection of County Road 801 and SR 58 approximately 7 miles northeast of Ashland. The district covers 100.62 square miles and includes territory in Clearcreek, Jackson, Orange, Montgomery, Perry, Ruggles, and Troy townships.

The district borders on Wayne, Huron, Medina, Lorain and Richland Counties and district residents are part of the 16th Federal Congressional District, 19th or 22nd Ohio Senate District, and 73rd, 90th or 97th Ohio House Districts. The district population is 6,134 (2000 Census). The median income is \$31,213.

District: Mapleton Local School District is comprised of one elementary (K-6), and one junior high/high school (7-12). District expenditure per pupil in 2007 was \$7,263.

In 2006-2007 the district met 24 of the 30 indicators on the State Local Report Card and received an "Effective" rating and a Performance Index (PI) of 93.6 based on student performance on the Ohio Achievement Tests and Ohio Graduation Tests.

Faculty and Staff: Mapleton Local School District has 63 licensed/certified educators, one guidance counselor, two principals, one assistant principal, two athletic directors, and 58 support staff. 52.7% of the instructional staff hold a master's degree, and three are National Board Certified.

Enrollment 2007-2008: District enrollment K-12 is 1,042. Building level enrollment is Mapleton Elementary School (K-6) 562 and Mapleton Junior High/ High School (7-12) 480.

Students with Special Needs K-12

The Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act provide that no individual will be discriminated against on the basis of a disability. This protection applies not just to the student, but to all individuals who have access to the District's programs and facilities.

A student can access special education services through the proper evaluation procedures. Parent involvement in this procedure is important and required by Federal (IDEA) and State law.
