a juried art show & competition

Art Show will include booths that will display a qualified artist's work that can be purchased during the River Country Chamber of Commerce of Newaygo County 2019 Arts & Crafts Festival in Newaygo May 24 - 26, 2019

Art Competition will be an installation of the artist's (or team) work at sponsored locations throughout Newaygo from May 10, 2019 – June 10, 2019

Art Show Details:

Fee is \$75.00 for a 10x10 lot for their booth (non-refundable for withdrawal by applicant).

Art Show candidates will need to submit an online application along with 3 photos of their art that will be on display to be sold. Submit photos to info@rivercountrychamber.com no later than April 1st. All applications will be reviewed by a 5 person panel to determine qualification, applicants will be notified upon acceptance no later than April 12th. Payment is required at time of application, payment will be refunded if not accepted.

Art Competition Details:

Fee is \$25.00 per entry (non-refundable for withdrawal by applicant).

Applicant does not have to be entered in the Art Show to enter competition; Dual entry (Art Show & Art Competition) is \$90.00 (non-refundable for withdrawal by applicant).

Candidates will need to submit online application along with 3 photos of the piece to be entered. Submit photos to info@rivercountrychamber.com no later than April 1st, applicants will be notified upon acceptance no later than April 12th. Payment is required at time of application, payment will be refunded if not accepted.

Installation of applicant's art to begin no earlier than May 3rd and tear down no later than June 14th

Judging of entries will take place on May 25th, winners will be notified by end of business.
1st Place \$500.00 2nd Place \$250.00 3rd Place \$100.00

People Choice voting to take place May 24th – 26th with winners to be announced Tuesday, May 28th.

All winners will have the option to display artwork throughout Labor Day weekend at locations throughout Newaygo.

Requirements for ALL art pieces being entered into Competition

1. Every art piece will be reviewed and determined by the approval panel appointed by the art committee.
2. All artist must be at least 18 years of age.
3. All members of the artist's team (if applicable) must be at least 18 years of age.
4. The artist(s) is responsible for setting up and removing their art pieces at the end of each event
5. The artist agrees to allow the City of Newaygo and the RC3 Art Committee to capture any photos and/or videos of the art pieces and use for any promotional use.
6. Artist must provide warning sign visible to bystanders informing them to keep back and or do not touch. If a barrier is required, it is the responsibility of the applicant.
7. Artist accepts and assumes all liability and must maintain and upkeep the piece.
8. City, River Country Chamber and Members of the committee or not liable or responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged pieces or any harm caused.**
9. City and/or RC3 art committee reserves the right to have the artist remove the piece at any time. If Artist does not remove piece on demand, then City will remove the piece and immediately dispose. Artist will be responsible to pay for any and all costs for the City removing the piece within 30 days of action.
10. Artwork must be your own original work completed by entrant.
11. Artwork must not have been entered in a previous contest.
12. Other prohibited criteria: nudity, hate, sexually explicit, profanity, bright lights, highly reflective, projectiles, falling items, unbalanced, moving parts, harmful materials, nuisance noises
13. Must not have electricity or batteries.

Purchase Insurance through Fractured Atlas

As a member of Fractured Atlas you have access to a limited but vast selection of services, including high-quality, low-cost liability, property, and casualty coverage for all types of artists and their work.

A few things to keep in mind:

General Liability coverage covers damage to Venues and uninvolved bystanders, but does not cover damage to your Artwork. Artwork coverage needs to be purchased separately.+

Artwork coverage is annual, carries a minimum premium of \$580, and has a \$500 deductible. Most people who choose to purchase Artwork coverage either have an expensive piece being shown at the event, or decided to cover all their entire body of work that they have on display, in their studio, and in storage. If you are only looking to cover one piece of art valued at under \$1,200, purchasing this Artwork coverage isn't advisable.

Short-term General Liability coverage (also known as an Event policy) is short-term, but the cost is usually determined by the number of spectators that your piece will have during that period. Artwork that is in high-traffic areas can make for expensive short-term policies. In instances like this, it tends to be less expensive to purchase an annual Artwork coverage policy, because the premium is calculated differently. Also, an annual policy will cover you anywhere in the USA (including your studio), not just on the premises of the ArtPrize event.

Additional Requirements for 2D Art pieces being entered into Competition

1. Shall be no bigger than 5ft x 5ft
2. Artist will provide all materials and method of display
3. All mediums are acceptable (painting, canvas, paper wood ect)

Additional Requirements for 3D Art pieces being entered into Competition

1. Size: Minimum - Must not be less than 2ft tall while maintaining balance on its own.
Maximum - Must not exceed a max height width or depth of 10ft while maintaining balance on its own.
2. Weight: Must be sustainable weight while not cause damage to the environment.
3. Must have own platform and be secured.

Additional Requirements for exterior pieces being entered into Competition

1. Must be resistant to outdoor elements including rain, snow, ice, and wind.
2. City will maintain upkeep of the environment around the art piece.
