Recorder's Office to Offer Online Searches

Peoria County - On July 13, 2015, the Peoria County Recorder of Deeds Office is launching a software system that enables free online searches of public records dating back to 1987; older records will be added in the future. The new service allows homeowners to access mortgage and deed information from the convenience of their home or office rather than visiting the Peoria County Courthouse. Individuals will have the option to print their property records for \$5.00 with a debit or credit card. For the general public and those conducting multiple searches, such as title companies, attorneys, or financial institutions, the following user fee schedule will become effective July 13:

After July 13, anyone wishing to perform a property record search may access the system through a link from the county's website or at <http://recorder.peoriacounty.org>

In addition to property records such as deeds, mortgages, liens, and mortgage releases, searches for judgments, plats and surveys, municipal ordinances, Powers of Attorney, and more can be conducted online with the new system, which enhances customer service for both homeowners and commercial users. The latter will also benefit from e-recording, which coincides with the July launch date and expedites record-filing procedures. The system also includes a fraud guard feature to prevent property fraud, a form of identity theft and the fastest growing white collar crime in America. The feature prevents criminals from acquiring a homeowners' property deed to use as collateral for large purchases.
