Awards available for nominations:

Chamber Member of the Year

- Awarded to an individual
- Must be an active and engaged member of the Beavercreek Chamber of Commerce, in good standing
- Must have performed exemplary acts to promote the mission of the Chamber

Outstanding Business/Business Person of the Year Award

- Must be an active and engaged member of the Beavercreek Chamber of Commerce, in good standing
- Must be located in Beavercreek
- Must have positively impacted the Beavercreek business community

Outstanding Young Person of the Year Award

- Must be an individual or organization comprised of individuals under the age of 21
- Must be a Beavercreek resident
- Must have performed outstanding service for the betterment of the Beavercreek Community or humanity
- Must possess good moral character

E.G. Shaw Lifetime Achievement Award

- Individual's activities must exemplify the character and memory of E.G. Shaw
 - Service to others
 - Characteristics including honesty, sincerity, integrity, and benevolence
- Must be a Beaver Creek Chamber member in good standing
- Must have performed prolonged outstanding service for the betterment of the Beaver Creek Community

Military Award (In Memory of Ret. Col. Len Holihan)

- May be awarded to an individual or an organization who has enhanced the relationship between the Beaver Creek community and the military

Gussie Jones Civic Award

- May be awarded to an individual or an organization
- Must have performed outstanding service for the betterment of the Beaver Creek Community
- Must possess characteristics including honesty, sincerity, integrity, and benevolence

Nutter Humanitarian Award

- Individual's activities must exemplify the character and memory of E. J. Nutter
 - Service to others
 - Characteristics including honesty, sincerity, integrity, and benevolence
- Must be a Beaver Creek Chamber member in good standing
- Must have performed philanthropic acts for the betterment of humanity
