**ALL ENTRIES MUST ABIDE BY THE RULES SET FORTH BY THE
GREENVILLE AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE.**

RULES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- **IMPORTANT: Entries WILL be allowed to throw candy, ONLY if an adult is walking along EACH side, keeping entry and onlookers safe. You do not have to pay a “Walkers” Fee for these participants (limit to two “safety” walkers, one on each side of float/car/utility vehicle. If the rules are not followed, your entry is subject to disqualification and removal from the parade lineup.**
- ***All truck/tractor/utility vehicle/vehicle/off road vehicle operators must be 18 years of age or older*** and possess a valid driver’s license. Car, motorcycle and four-wheeler drivers must possess a valid driver’s license. All drivers are restricted from stunt driving. If at any time during the parade, the operator of the vehicle does not adhere to the safety guidelines set forth by the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce and the Greenville Police Department, your entry will be subject to disqualification and removal from the parade lineup.
- All entries with riders must be secured with raised sides on the vehicles or floats and all children must be supervised and accompanied by adults either as a “safety” walker or a rider inside the float or vehicle.
- It is the responsibility of the group/organization to follow rules and regulations set forth by the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce and the Greenville Police Department.
- All entrants are responsible for making sure their vehicle, float, etc. is well lit and meets all safety guidelines outline in application form.
- All entries are subject to inspection by Chamber and City of Greenville (Greenville Police Department) officials who reserve the right to remove any entrant from the parade if rules are not followed or if safety is an issue or concern.
- Check in to line up for the parade will begin at 5 p.m. Contact person must notify line up coordinator upon arrival. All entrants must be in the lineup by 6 p.m. sharp or entry will be eliminated. The parade will begin at 6:30 p.m. sharp.
- All entries will be assigned a number before the parade and those numbers must be posted and visible on the left side of the front windshield on all vehicles as well as visible on marching and walking groups.
- Floats/Utility Vehicles/Vehicles/Off Road Vehicles will assemble in their assigned numerical slots designated by the GACOC beginning at the corner of Commerce and Bolling Streets. The route will extend from there to the corner of Bolling and Herbert Street in front of Pioneer Electric.
- Only parade entries will be allowed to get to the lineup. Please inform your float riders or their parents to park elsewhere and walk their child to their designated group.
- The parade route will begin on Commerce Street at the entrance to Boiling Street. No unloading of riders will be allowed at the Courthouse. At the end of the route you must return to the starting point using Walnut, Church and Herbert Street.
- Entries must keep a distance of 30 feet, not to exceed 50 feet, from the preceding entry.
- Remember **THERE IS ONLY ONE SANTA IN THE PARADE**. Please do not have a “live” Santa on your entry.
- No saddle clubs will be allowed in the parade. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place in float and decorated vehicle entries. Remember, lights and music should be in line with the theme of the parade.
- No profane language or content is allowed. This includes display of obscene or offensive language on vehicle, clothing, or music being played inside or around the float/vehicle.
- All members of the Greenville Area Chamber of Commerce, City of Greenville or any person or group associated with the Parade are released from any liabilities for accidents, injuries, etc. that may occur during the parade.

I agree to all rules as outlined above and agree to abide by directives given at the time of the lineup and time of the parade.
