CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: LAKEVIEW LOW-LINE PHASES 1B AND 2 September 9, 2019



Construction of Phases 1b and 2 will occur in the area highlighted in green above.

WHAT: Beginning this September, work will resume on Phases 1b and 2 of the Low-Line project. This includes the creation of new public plazas at Ashland, funded by Special Service Area (SSA) 27, and the completion of a pathway connecting Paulina and Ashland plazas, funded by Friends of Lakeview. The following improvements will be introduced as part of Phases 1b and 2:

- A concrete and gravel hardscape and pathway connecting Paulina and Ashland
- Lighting elements, including interactive light boxes along the Low-Line pathway
- Art panels and murals on existing buildings
- A new park at Marshfield Avenue, complete with an urban forest, planted mounds, and seating

WHERE: Along a portion of the future Low-Line pathway, beneath the CTA Brown Line 'L' tracks between Paulina and Ashland (highlighted in green on the map above).

WHEN: Phase 1b will begin the week of September 16, and is estimated to take approximately 6 weeks to complete. Check back for updates regarding Phase 2 timeline.

IMPACTS: Impacts will be minimal with all work situated beneath the CTA right-of-way. The Lakeview Chamber of Commerce will work together with the CTA to notify the community and commuters of any potential impacts due to construction.
