 - Stay up-to-date on events and promotions happening with businesses in the neighborhood
- Street Team & Print Marketing
 - Create strategic plan for placing event posters in local businesses and organizations
 - Distribute Lakeview neighborhood guides to businesses in Lakeview
- Event Production
 - Assist with the setup and execution of PorchFest Lakeview (June 7), Low-Line Market (Thursdays, June 4 - October 15) & Lakeview Live (Wednesdays, July 1 - August 26)
