





RE: Madison Street Improvements Project Update

Dear Madison Street Neighbors and Businesses:

The upcoming construction improvements to Madison Street will **start on April 15th** and be completed in the Fall of 2019. As a part of the improvements, Madison Street, between Harlem Avenue and Austin Boulevard, will be resurfaced with new, smooth pavement and converted to three lanes. Pedestrian crossings will be shorter and safer when new accessible ramps, marked crosswalks, bump-outs, pedestrian refuges and enhanced signals are installed. Parking spaces will be restriped, bicycle lanes will be marked on the pavement and Pace bus stops will be posted.

This construction project has been awarded to K-Five Construction and is expected to follow the schedule shown in the graphic below.



The improvement project will often seem to have frequent “starts and stops.” It is important to understand that with a project of this magnitude, it may often appear that no road work is occurring. However, this will not be the case. As an example, much of the work for the first six weeks of the improvement project will involve removing medians and replacing them with pavement. This means that residents and businesses on the west end of Madison will have limited exposure to construction activities until the end of May.

Madison Street will remain open to traffic throughout construction and the engineering team will work to ensure that safe, passable walking routes are maintained. If there are any disruptions planned for access to properties along Madison, notice will be provided to specific Madison Street property/business owners 48 hours in advance.

We do not anticipate any disruptions or changes to refuse collection as a result of this construction project. However, if there are disruptions the properties effected will be notified in advance and accommodations will be arranged.

There will be periods of time in which sections of parking will be disrupted. We are working through the timing of the “rolling” parking disruptions in order to lessen those impacts. If you have specific parking related concerns, please email your concerns to me at cbaker@ehancock.com.
