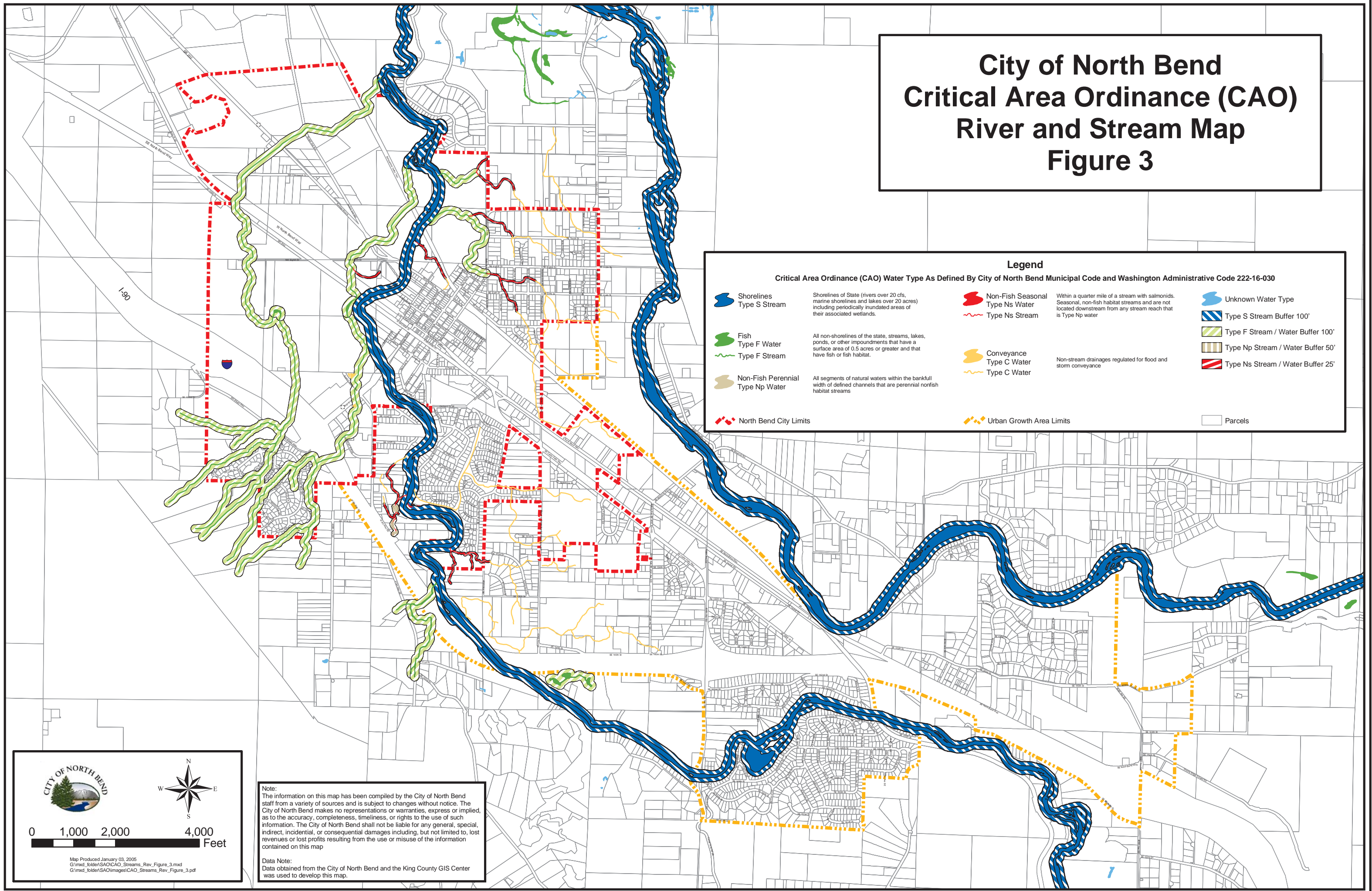


City of North Bend Critical Area Ordinance (CAO) River and Stream Map Figure 3
