Any of the following shall result in automatic dismissal:

- Full tuition payment not received on or before December 1, 2019.
- Absences or partial absences from program sessions exceeding, in the aggregate, sixteen (16) hours or more.
- Three (3) occasions of either late arrival to or early departure from program session where the absence exceeds thirty (30) minutes. Leaving a program session in process for more than thirty (30) minutes shall be counted as one occasion of early departure, whether or not the participant returns. This includes leaving at or during mealtimes.

- Failure to complete extracurricular activities *one week prior to Graduation*.

All absences, late arrivals, and early departures (regardless of nature) will count against the attendance requirements. Advance notification should be given to the Chamber contact, and if at all possible, advise your group Point of Contact.

Engaging in improper, threatening and/or harassing behavior at any Chamber event may lead to removal from the program without reimbursement.

In all LCC Class matters, the Chamber Foundation's decision will be final.
