Most sessions will be held the second Thursday of each month from 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Dress code for sessions is **Business Dress** unless stated by Steering Committee or Chamber Representative.

Agendas will be posted to the class Facebook group and emailed the Friday before a session.

The program consists of ten (10) monthly sessions. Opening retreat is mandatory and is an overnight session. Closing session is mandatory. The State and Federal session is an overnight trip to Austin. Attendance at all sessions is expected, however, a sixteen (16) hour absence allowance is allowed in extreme situations.

Any of the following shall result in automatic dismissal:

- Full tuition payment not received on or before December 1, 2020.
- Absences or partial absences from program sessions exceeding, more than sixteen (16) hours.
- Three (3) occasions of either late arrival to or early departure from program session which exceeds thirty (30) minutes. Leaving a program session in process for more than thirty (30) minutes shall be counted as an early departure, whether or not the participant returns. This includes leaving at or during mealtimes.
- Failure to complete extracurricular activities one week prior to Graduation.

All absences, late arrivals, and early departures (regardless of nature) will count against the attendance requirements. Advance notification should be given to the Chamber contact, and if possible, advise your group Point of Contact.

In addition to these regular sessions, participants will be required to participate in extracurricular related to the Leadership Corpus Christi program. The nature of the activities will be left to the discretion of the General Chair.

Participants are offered many other optional opportunities to learn about Corpus Christi and its issues. Although attendance is not required, participants certainly benefit personally from participation in as many of these optional activities.
