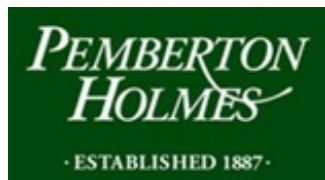

**Cowichan Therapeutic Riding Associations' Annual Round-Up Fundraiser - Sept. 26**

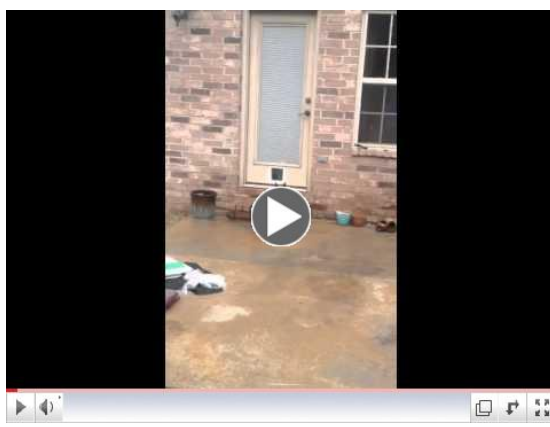
