Canadian companies hungry for growth are still turning to the U.S. market

The U.S. is Canada's largest trading partner, the destination for some 75 per cent of all Canadian exports. More than \$500 billion in goods, alone, cross over our borders

annually. Although Canadian companies are seeing the value in diversification, the U.S., with its large population representing one-fifth of the global economy, is still a top choice for Canadian companies looking to get a foothold internationally. The new U.S.-Mexico-Canada Agreement secures this bilateral trade for the future.

Insurance Industry & Calgary Chamber of Commerce launch tool to prepare small businesses for disasters
