

Middlesex County Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Descriptions

The Harry H. S. Phillips, Jr. Scholarship - \$4,000.00 Award (approximate) (Award may vary based on interest income on principal)

The criteria for selection is NEED. A student who although is not top ranked academically, but is highly motivated, has a positive attitude toward learning, ranked high enough academically that acceptance in post secondary school is assured, has been involved in community service and has indicated the objectives and purpose of seeking additional schooling is eligible.

The criteria to be used in selecting scholarship winners shall include:

1. Need – this is the main criteria in selection of the Phillips scholarship – 50%
2. Academic Achievement – 20%
3. Motivation & Purpose – 10 %
4. Citizenship and/or volunteerism – 10%
5. Extra Curricular activity and/or work experience – 10%

The Raymond E. Baldwin Scholarship - \$2,000.00 Award

This scholarship is awarded in honor of the late Raymond E. Baldwin who served the State of Connecticut as Governor, United State Senator and Supreme Court Justice. The criterion for selection of the recipient of this scholarship is ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT.

The criteria to be used in selecting scholarship winners shall include:

1. Academic Achievement – the basis of the Baldwin scholarship – 50%
2. Need – 20%
3. Motivation – 10%
4. Citizenship and/or volunteerism – 10%
5. Extra Curricular activity and/or work experience – 10%

Lorraine C. McHugh Scholarship - \$2,000 Award

This scholarship is awarded in honor of the late Lorraine C. McHugh. The scholarship will be awarded to a graduating High School senior who will be attending one of the four **Connecticut State University System Schools – Central, Eastern, Southern and Western Connecticut State Universities – INCLUDING THE UNIVERSITY OF CONNECTICUT**. The criteria for selection are based on scholastic achievement, extra-curricular excellence and community service involvement. This individual should be highly motivated with a positive attitude toward learning.

The Criteria to be used in selecting scholarship winners shall include:

1. Extra-Curricular Excellence – 40%
2. Citizenship Qualities – 30%
3. Scholastic Achievement – 20%
4. Motivation and Attitude – 10%

The Scholarships will be awarded at the Middlesex County Chamber of Commerce Annual Dinner on June 5, 2019.
The award winner must be present at the dinner.

Scholarship applications must be accompanied with the following information:

- Transcript
- FAFSA
- Letters of Recommendation
- Student Summary/Biography
- SAT Scores
- Autobiographical Essay
